12 years old. She entered the Visual Arts Workshop in 2022.

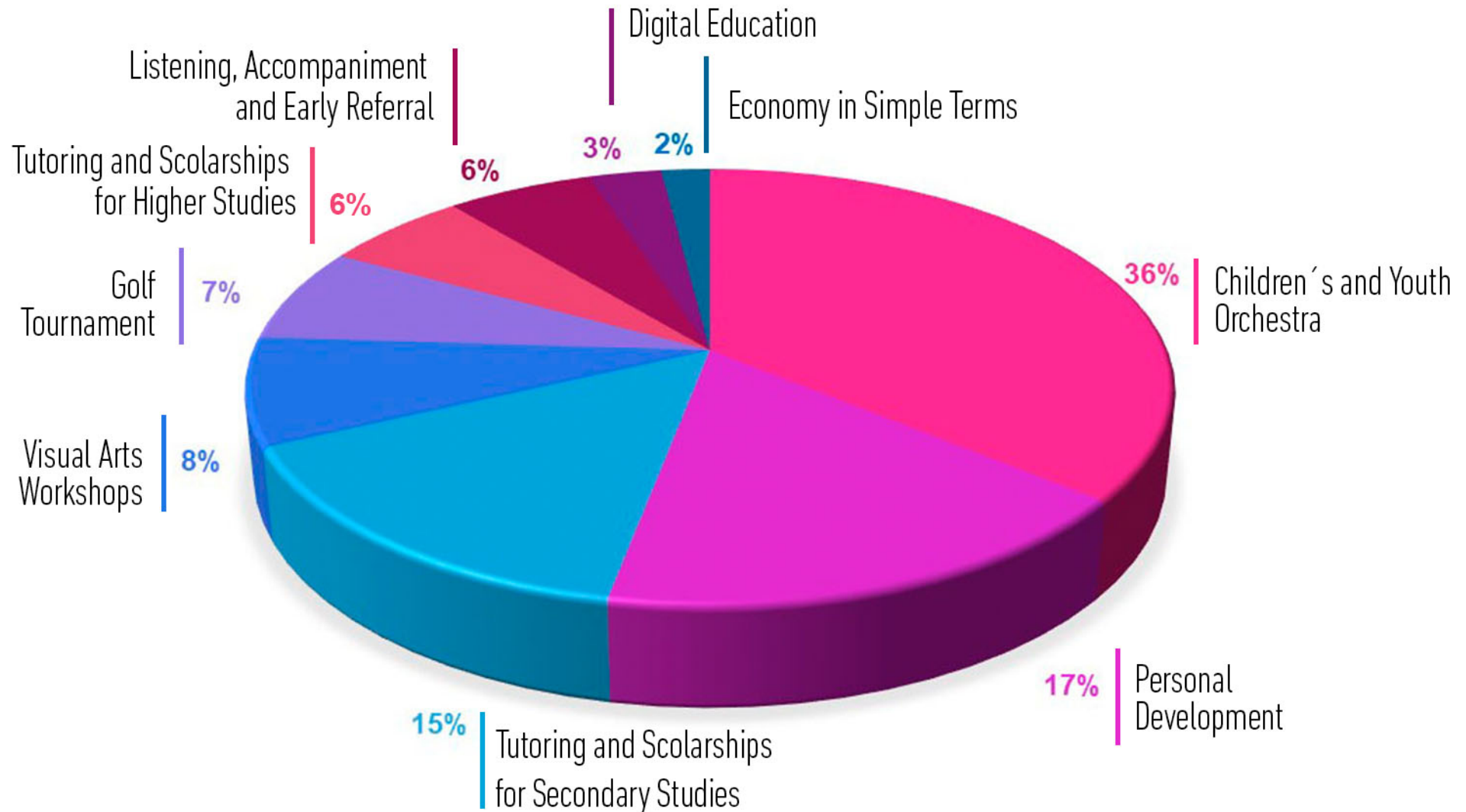
"I like drawing, painting, making collages and learning new things. I love being in the NGO because it's so beautiful and I feel very good here."

Gabriel completed much of the course at the NGO's facilities, using the computers set up for the students.



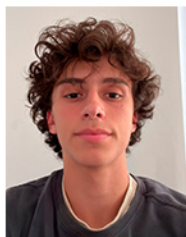


ENGLISH CLASSES

- ▶ The objective is to understand our context and incorporate tools of action and analysis for life.

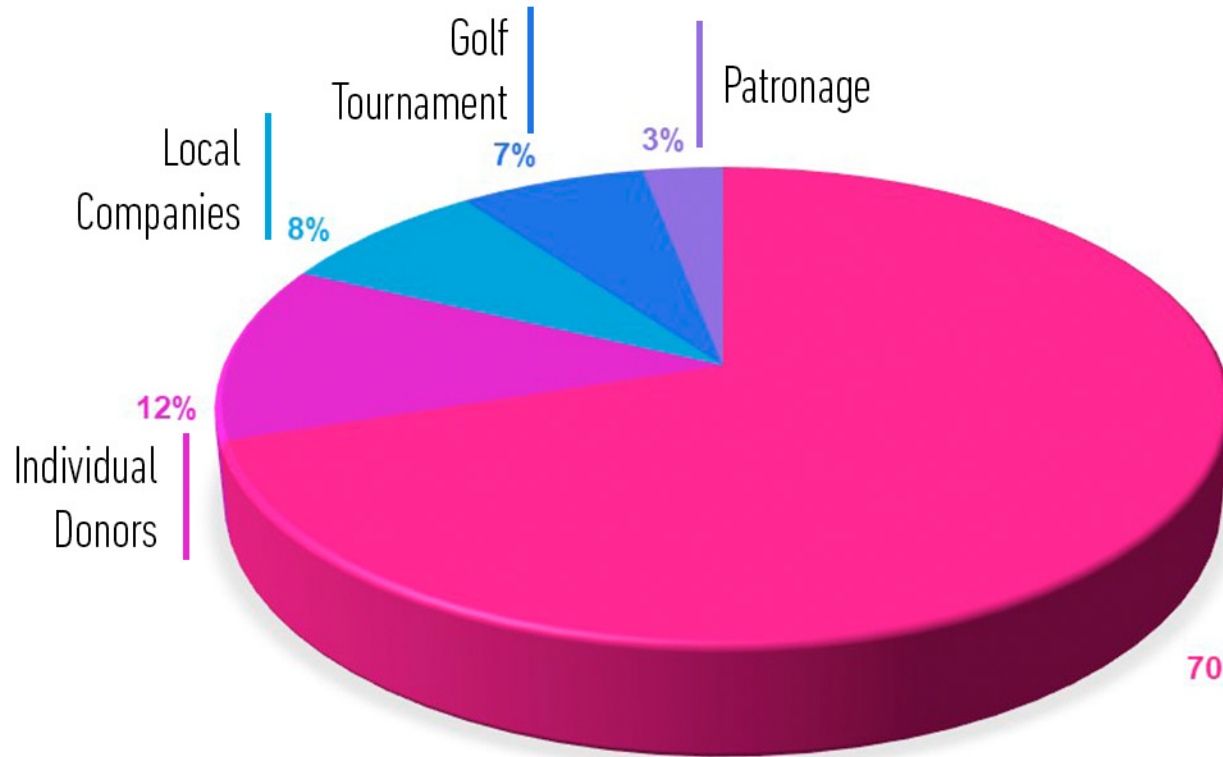


PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT
